#8 Classic Legacy (7/2) – just missed last out (only beaten a nose) at Churchill – he is the Lone Closer in here – the slight added dist. should be o.k. – earned the best last race Bris Late pace no. – ran 2nd in each of last 3 races (*should be enough early speed in here to set him up*) – has the best speed rating at this dist. – has run to PAR for this level - Alvarado rides for Mott.

#4 Suerte (6-1) – ran a decent 4th last out - making 1st start off a 3 month layoff (trainer hits @16/40%) – shows 2 recent Bullet works – trainer Maker looks to have him ready for big effort – Saez rides for the 1st time (jock/trainer hit @ 31/54%) – he will be forwardly placed.

#3 General Partner (5/2) – making 1st start off a 7 month layoff (trainer hits @26/55%) – last race was in the BC Juvenile (ran 6th after setting the pace) – is getting 1st time Lasix (trainer hits @27/58%) – has a win over this track– looks to be the pace setter in here (*will be playing come catch me if you can*) – is the Bris Prime Power leader & Class leader – trainer Brown had him entered in a race on Friday but opted for this level!

#5 Quick to Accuse (7/2) – won last 2 races (since coming into the Brad Cox barn) – making 3rd start off a 2 month layoff (trainer hits @24/55%) – very good jock/trainer team (they hit @27/67%) – trainer Cox does well in Allowance races (hits @28/62%) – will be rated behind the pace setter.

#7 Vespucci (10-1) – ran a decent 3rd last out as the favorite – trainer hits @ 33/53% nxt. out with beaten favorites – won on Debut last year – making his 5th career start today - he looks to be ratable behind the early leaders .

#6 Spaliday (3-1) – broke her Maiden last race (trainer hits @ 25/56% nxt. out) – making 3rd start off a 2 month layoff – shows increased Beyer speed nos. in each of her races – she is 1 of only 2 Closers in here – is the Brise Prime Power leader - has very good Turf pedigree – Chad Brown has 2 runners in here (both are live) – showed good Late turn-of-foot in last race – Irad Ortiz, Jr. gets on for the 1st time!

#4 Storm Miami (Ire) (10-1) – making 2nd U.S. start for trainer Walsh (he hits @ 17/41%) - ran a good 4th (only beaten 3 1/4 lengths) last race – did not get enough pace to close into (that will not be a problem today) – she looks like her best racing is mid-pack waiting to move on the leaders when she hits the lane – is the Bris Class leader – will like a little give in the ground – Gaffalione rides for the 1st time.

#1A Source (GB) (7/2) – making 1st start in the U.S. (may need a race) - making 1st Turf start for Graham Motion – has very good Turf pedigree – sire runners win @ 20% with 1sters (the DAM has produced a turf winner) – won her Debut on the All Weather in France - gets 1st time Lasix – will be in post #12 which is not ideal – Rosario is set to ride.

#5 Lady de Berry (4-1) – making 1st start of the year for trainer Chad Brown – making 1st start off a 7 month layoff (trainer hits @26/55%) – just missed last race at Del Mar in G3 Stakes (only beaten 1 length) – best Turf speed is better than the average winning speed - she gets 1st time Lasix (trainer hits @27/58%) – drops in Class today (can only help her today) - looks to be on or near the lead – Chad Brown one of the best Turf trainers (hits @ 23/55%) – good Turf jock Prat rides back (he hits @20/42%).

#11 Agra (8-1) – ran a very good 3rd (only beaten 2 ½ lengths) last out – making 2nd start off the layoff (trainer hits @ 19/54%) - has good Turf pedigree – she is a Closer that does not need to be racing at the back of the field – Johnny V. rides for Bill Mott.

#8 Full Screen (7/2) – just missed last out (only beaten 1 length) at long dist. – making 1st start off a brief layoff (trainer hits @15/44%) – has Early speed & the cut back in dist. should benefit him today – he will be on the front end as a pace setter (can he hang on) – Irad takes the mount for Casse – earned Beyer speed no. of 95 in last race.

#5 Subrogate (5-1) won last race vs. similar (trainer hits @ 16/55% nxt. out) – making 2nd start of the year – shows recent Bullet works – looks to be ratable just off the pace – has one of the best speed nos. at this dist. – Arrogate sired (\$250K purchase) - Ruiz gets on for the 1st time (jock/trainer hits @60/100%).

#6 Awesome Native (4-1) – making 1st start for new trainer (Finger lakes based) – ran a very good 2nd (only beaten by a neck) last race – has been the favorite in 7 of last 8 races - making 1st start off a 6 month layoff (trainer hits @10/40%) – shows recent Bullet work over this track - has the best Bris last race Late speed no. – Rosario rides .

#7 Life Changer (10-1) – ran a solid last race at Aqueduct – has good Dirt form – he likes this track (3-1-1-1) – showed very good Late pace nos. last out – he will be racing in a Stalking style – trainer Potts gets Castellano to ride!

#9 Thrill of It (10-1) – is the Lone Closer in here (should be enough early speed today to set him up at the end) – was 7 wide in last race – his best dirt speed is close average winning speed.

#5 Gun Pilot (1-1) – favorites have won last 6 editions – has won 3 of last 4 races - he Presses the pace setters and makes a big move late – won last race which was a Grade 1 at Churchill – earned a beyer 100 speed rating last out (best in the field) - has earned the best last race Bris Late Pace nos. – is the top ranked Bris Prime Power & Class rating – Asmussen trains with Torres on.

#1 Ninetypercentmaddie (8-1) – has been 2nd in last 3 races – he is the Lone Closer in here (should be lots of early speed) – making 3rd start off a 5 month layoff (trainer hits @18/59%) – earned career best Beyer speed no. in last 2 races – Parx based runner ships in for trainer Reid – good Sprint jock Lezcano rides for the 1st time.

#2 Rotknee (6-1) – won last race (at Aqueduct) – trainer hits @ 19/48% with next out starters – making 2nd start off the layoff (trainer hits @17/48%) – has a win over the Saratoga track – has won 8 of 12 dirt races – he will be one of the pace setters - trainer Maker knows how to pull off upsets – Franco rides back.

#4 Accretive (5-1) – ran a very good 2nd (only beaten a neck) last out – has good Dirt form – ran 2nd in last 2 races – making 3rd start off 10 week layoff (trainer hits @28/63%) - shows good pattern of works – slight cut back in dist. can only help - trainer Brown excels in Graded Stakes (hits @21/52%) – Irad Ortiz rides (jock trainer team hits @45/65%).

(18-5-2-5) – his mid-race speed nos. are the best of the field - can rate behind the pace setters – regular jock Saez sticks for Mott.

#3 Carl Spackler (2-1) – main competition to our top pick – won last 3 races – has only been out of the Exacta once in 6 races – is 2 for 2 at on Saratoga Turf – 3 for 3 at this dist. - making 2nd start off 8 month layoff (trainer hits @29/64%) – shows Sharp recent work - earned best last race Bris Late pace nos. – trained by Chad Brown (if anyone can beat our top pick it is he).

#1 Mysterious (Ire) (10-1) – Euro invader for Appleby / Godolphin – making 1st start off 3 month layoff (trainer hits @33/78%) – gets weight off – raced at Saratoga last year in Hall of Fame S. (finished 7th after setting the pace – look for different tactics this time) – shows Bullet

work over the Saratoga Turf – regular rider William Buick is here to ride.

#7 Talk of the Nation (7/2) – ran 2nd (only beaten a Head) in last race – only out of the Exacta once in 9 career races – loves this dist. (6-2-4-0) – making 2nd start in the Pletcher barn (hits @19/44%) – he will be forwardly placed – Irad rides for Pletcher – Pletcher has won 2 of last 4 editions!

#6 Kubrick (Ire) (8-1) – making 3rd start in the U.S. – ran 6th last out in the G1 Makers Mark Mile – won his 1st start in the U.S. – has 3 wins at this 1 Mile dist. – has the best Turf pedigree in here – looks like he needs to rate behind the pace setters to get his best race – Prat rides for Chad Brown (Brown won this race 2 years ago).

#4 Charge It (5/2) – won this race last year – ran a solid 3rd last out making his 1st start in 6 months – trainer Pletcher hits @25/55% making 2nd start off long layoff – he is the Bris Prime Power leader – earned the best Bris last out Late Pace nos. - earned a 90 Beyer speed rating in last race (look for that to improve today) – he will be a pace setter in here – trainer Pletcher has won this race in each of the last 2 years – Johnny V. maintains the ride.

#7 Crupi (3-1) – 2nd runner in here for Pletcher – making 1st start since the Dubai World Cup where he did not run well – ran a very good 3rd 2 races back in the Pegasus World Cup Inv. (beaten 4 ¾ lengths) – he is the Bris top Class rated horse - has not won a Graded Stakes race yet – looks to do his best running when racing behind the front runners and close late on them – Irad rides for the 1st time.

#5 Idiomatic (3/5) – the one to beat - she has won 9 of last 10 races (including 4 Grade 1) – she was near perfect last year (9-8-1-0) and is off to a good start this year – won the BC Distaff last year - making 2nd start off a 6 month layoff (trainer hits @27/60%) – has run to PAR for this level - she is a Early Speed runner but can rate if need be - is the Bris Prime Power & Class leader - trainer Cox looking for his 1st win in this race – Geroux rides back.

#3 Pretty Mischievous (6-1) – has won 6 of last 9 races - making 2nd start off long layoff (trainer hits @ 22/48%) – she will be stalking the leaders – has a win over this track – has a win at this dist. – won the KY Oaks last year – comes out of the Godolphin / Walsh barn – regular jock Gaffalione rides.
