Daily Double / Exacta / Trifecta / Superfecta / Pick 3 (Races 1-2-3) / Pick 5 (Races 1-5)

#2 Pure Force (5/2) – Juddmonte homebred making Debut today (trainer hits @22/53%) – sire 1sters win at 17% clip – DAM has produced 1 winner from 1 starter – shows good pattern of Sharp works – Geroux rides for Brad Cox (they hit @ 31/59%) – small field should be to his advantage.

#6 House United (5-1) – making  $2^{nd}$  career start – ran a decent  $4^{th}$  in debut - get Blinkers On today – run line comment was "willingly" (usually indicates good effort nxt time) – jock chg to Leparoux.

#7 Culprit (7/2) – making  $1^{st}$  start off a 9 month layoff (trainer hits @ 26/53%) – trainer Ward is taking the Blinkers OFF today (hits @28/56%) – going Turf to Dirt (trainer hits @42%) – shows good pattern of works – jock chg. to Johnny V. (team hits @44/63%).

#1 Evan On Earth (3-1) – making  $1^{st}$  start off a 3 month layoff (trainer hits @22/46%) – has run well I his 3 career races (3-0-1-1) – last race was on a sloppy track (he finished  $4^{th}$ ) – his best dirt speed is the best in the field - ships in from Fair Grounds.

#5 Lou's Legacy (6-1) – ran 3rd in last race (moved up to  $2^{nd}$  via DQ) – is the Bris Prime Power leader and Bris top Class rated horse – has not been off the board in 3 races this year – he will rate behind the pace setters.

#6 Scylla (6/5) – ran  $3^{rd}$  last out in G3 Stakes – drops in Class (will appreciate the relief) – making  $3^{rd}$  start off the bench (trainer hits @16/46%) – has never been off-the-board (4-2-1-1) – is the Bris Prime Power leader & top Bris Class horse – Juddmonte runner comes from the Mott barn – Castellano keeps the mount.

#4 Steel Racer (8-1) – won last out at Gulfstream – making 1st start in new barn (trainer hits @ 26/51%) – earned career best Speed no. in last race – likes this dist. (6-3-1-0) – will be pressing the pace setters – has a win over this track – Irad Ortiz, Jr. rides.

#9 Invigorated (9/2) – won his debut last out at Gulfstream (trainer Pletcher hits @24/56% nxt. Out) – earned a 88 Beyer – trainer excels in Allowance level races (hits @22/49%) – shows good recent works – Saez replaces Irad Ortiz – ships in from Gulfstream (trainer hits @23/54%) – he is a Closer – earned best Bris last out Late speed no. – debut race was around 2-turns and so is today's race!

#11 Mindframe (2-1) – won Debut race by 13 ¾ lengths at Gulfstream (trainer hits @ 24/55% nxt out) – earned a big 103 Beyer speed no. (best in the field) - is the Bris Prime Power leader – Debut race was around 1-turn (today is 2-turns) – the slight added dist. should not be a problem - Todd Pletcher trains both of our top 2 picks in here – Repole owns both of them – Irad keeps this mount over our top pick - he looks to rate behind the pace setters but he might be it..

#2 Cornishman (5-1) – broke his Maiden in last race (trainer hits @25/58% nxt. out) – each of his 3 races show increased speed nos. (needs to keep improving to beat the top 2) – he will be forwardly placed and can rate – has not been out of the Exacta in 3 career races (3-1-2-0) – exits a Key race - is a Godolphin homebred in the Brad Cox barn – Hot jock/trainer team (hit @31/59%)

#1 Cartucho (4-1) – won Debut by 6 3/4 lengths at Tampa Bay (trainer hits @25/56% nxt. Out) – was a \$1.2 Million purchase – stretching out to a Route dist. (trainer Brown hits @29/63%) – looks

to be rated behind the pace setters – jock/trainer team hits @40/60%.

#6 Nullify (15-1) – broke Maiden in last race (trainer Lukas hits @18/38% nxt. Out) – ships in from Oaklawn Park – earned career best Beyer speed 86 in last race - has run and won at this distance – shows Sharp recent work – Lukas runners are dangerous on big racing days!

#1 Strong Quality (4-1) – last 3 races on Turf – drops out of Graded Stakes (should appreciate the class relief) – cutback to a 1-turn Mile should improve his performance - has run well over

this track (3-1-2-0) – has run well on both Turf and Dirt – has the best dirt speed in the field - will be the pace leader as he is a need the lead to win type of runner – Geroux stays on for Casse.

#2 Denington (6-1) – is the Lone Closer in here – has 2 wins over this track – drops in Class today from G3 Stakes – making 2<sup>nd</sup> start off a 3 month layoff (trainer hits @19/43%) – should be enough speed in here for him to close into!

#4 Motorious (GB) (7/2) – making her 1st start of the year – ran 2<sup>nd</sup> in this race last year (only beaten3/4 length) – last race was the Breeders' Cup Turf Sprint where he finished a close 5<sup>th</sup> (only beaten 1 ½ lengths) – ships in from California for D'Amato (top Turf trainer on W. Coast) – has very good turn of foot – has run to PAR for this level – Prat rides.

#14 Cogburn (8-1) – won 3 of last 4 races – has been off since Sep. (well rested) - making 1<sup>st</sup> start of the year (has won previously off long layoff) – for a Sprint race there is not a lot of speed in the field which should benefit this guy – Asmussen gets Irad Ortiz to ride for the 1<sup>st</sup> time – likes the dist. (3-3-0-0) – he will be up close but can rate if need to – give in the ground O.K.

#8 Mischief Magic (Ire) (4-1) – making 2nd start of the year - Euro shipper making his  $2^{nd}$  U.S. start – ran a very good  $2^{nd}$  (only beaten 1 length) last out in the G2 Shakertown S. – is the Bris Prime Power leader – when the Godolphin/Appleby team ships them over they are ready to run - he is a Closer (big question is will there be enough pace up front) - Frankie rides!

#11 Coppice (GB) (5-1) – making 1<sup>st</sup> start in the U.S. (trainer Brown hits @28/53%) – Juddmonte homebred is now in the Chad Brown barn – making 1<sup>st</sup> start since October – shows good pattern of works since March down in Florida (likes like she is primed for a big effort) – won at Ascot last June – Frankie rides (he rode her 2 races back at Newmarket and in the Ascot race(so he knows her) – Brown has won the last 3 editions of this race!

#3 Chill Flag (Fr) (4-1) – won the G3 Honey Fox S. last out – making 1<sup>st</sup> start off a short layoff (trainer hits @24/58%) – is the Bris Prime Power leader – looks to have a good turn-of-foot – she is a Closer that will be coming on late – ships up from Florida for Chad Brown – slight cut back in distance may harm is Closing kick – top Turf jock Prat rides for trainer D'Amato (they hit @ 31/50%).

#8 Heavenly Sunday (6-1) – won last race in G3 Mrs. Revere S. by 5 lengths – earned the best last out speed rating – likes to be on or near the lead – making 1<sup>st</sup> start of the year (well rested) – shows recent Sharp works – making just her 2<sup>nd</sup> start on Dirt (first one was a win) – Geroux rides for Brad Cox (they hit @31/59%).
