#7 Takethefifth (6-1) – making 2<sup>nd</sup> start off a brief layoff – appears to be the Lone Closer in here – ran a good 2<sup>nd</sup> in last race (only beaten 1 ½ lengths) – has the best Turf speed in the field – has very good Turf pedigree – if the Turf comes up yielding he may have tough job closing on the pace setters – jock has been Hot lately for this trainer.

#1 Irish Heartbeat (3-1) – making 1<sup>st</sup> start off 6 week layoff – his Debut race 2 back was very good – getting 1<sup>st</sup> time Blinkers (trainer hits @13/40%) – shows a recent Bullet work – he will be tracking the pace setters - trainer Mike Maker does well with Turf runners – takes a bit of a Class drop today – good trainer jock team (they hit @25/54%).

#9 Lieutenant General (5/2) – making 2<sup>nd</sup> start of the year – making 1<sup>st</sup> start on Turf (trainer hits @19/50%) – takes Class drop today – pedigree does well 1<sup>st</sup> time on Turf – trainer Ward excels with Turf Sprint runners – is the Bris Prime Power leader – Johnny V. rides for the first time – jock/trainer team hit @45/65%.

#2 Laddie Dance (30-1) – making 1<sup>st</sup> start off 10 week layoff – going Dirt to Turf – lone turf race was over soft ground that he won wire-2-wire (before being DQ'd to 7<sup>th</sup>) – he looks to be the pace setter in here (can he hang on for the win)?.

#6 Maximillions Dream (10-1) – making 2<sup>nd</sup> career start – making 1<sup>st</sup> start since Oct. - making 1<sup>st</sup> start on Turf (trainer hits @4/26%) – gets 1<sup>st</sup> time Lasix (trainer hits @19/42%) – shows recent Sharp work (Lasix must be working).

#2 Porquerolles (8/5) – 2<sup>nd</sup> in last (only beaten a neck) – last race was a less than Firm ground – this 4-year old will be making just his 3<sup>rd</sup> career start – looks to be ratable behind the pace setters – making 2<sup>nd</sup> start off the layoff (trainer hits @18/52%) – gets some Class relief in here – Johnny V. keeps the mount for trainer Motion.

#4 Breakwater (3-1) – ran a good 2nd (only beaten 1 length) last out at this level - making just his 2nd start of the year – last race Beyer was close to PAR (the only one in here that was close) – last race was over less than Firm ground – shows Sharp recent work - trainer does well in Turf races (hits @ 17/48%) – very good Turf jock in Prat gets on for the 1<sup>st</sup> time for trainer McGaughey – he will be racing in a Pressing style a few lengths behind the front runners.

#5 St. John's (6-1) – ran a decent 3<sup>rd</sup> last out (only beaten 1 ¾ lengths) - making 3rd start off a 4 month layoff (trainer hits @ 34/60%) – 2 of his last 4 race have been over Hurdles at much longer distance – should appreciate the cut back in dist. – is the Bris Prime Power leader – very good Turf pedigree.

#8 Chelonian (5-1) – making 1<sup>st</sup> start off the Claim for Ness (trainer hits @32/68%) – ran 4th last race (only beaten ¾ lengths) – gets jock chg. To Rodriguez (jock/trainer hit @26/66%) – is moving up in Class slightly - if race comes off the Turf then he is a must use (has 16 dirt races & only 2 Turf).

#7 Rakia (10-1) – making 1<sup>st</sup> start off the Claim for De Paz – won last race (on dirt) – making 1<sup>st</sup> start on Turf (sire's off-spring win at 14%) – trainer gets Saez to ride – has run well on Dirt (now must do it on Turf) – if race comes off the Turf then he is a must use to Win & Place!

#1 Mirahmadi (7/5) – California shipper still looking to break his Maiden – making 1<sup>st</sup> start off 8 month layoff (trainer hits @26/60%) - has run to PAR for this level – drops out of Grade 1 race (should appreciate the Class relieve) – trainer Baffert is giving this guy 1<sup>st</sup> time Lasix (he hits @33/72%) – regular rider is in to ride.

#2 Whenlovetakesover (6-1) – won last race by 4 ½ lengths (trainer hits @16/47% nxt. Out) – making 2<sup>nd</sup> start after Claim – trainer re-claims him after losing him 3 races back – earned best Last Race Bris Late Pace nos. - ships in from NY (trainer hits @20/45%) – gets big jock chg. To Prat – he will be forwardly placed behind the #1 horse (can he stay with him?).

#7 Nasty Habit (9/2) – ran a good 3rd last out – has run to PAR for this level – only off the board once in 6 career races (6-1-2-2) trainer excels Sprint races hits @ 24/59% - trainer does well in Allow. Races (hits @21/56%) – Russell rides back – there is a lot of speed in here (he will be coming on late from the back of the field).

#3 Prado Road (8-1) – ran a decent 4<sup>th</sup> last out - making 1<sup>st</sup> start off a 2 month layoff (trainer hits @ 28/57%) – shows recent Sharp work – 2<sup>nd</sup> runner in here for Russell – has earned the best speed at this dist. – gets big jock chg. To Irad Ortiz (replacing Russell who is on #7) – has Early speed (just might get into a speed battle with the #1).

#4 Apple Picker (7/5) – drops out of Grade 3 Stakes in last 2 races (should appreciate the Class relief) – is the Bris Class leader – she is the Lone Closer in here (should get enough early speed to close into) - has done well at this distance (3-2-0-0) – making 2nd start off a short layoff – earned 100 Bris Late Pace nos. in last race - shows a Sharp recent work – Russell rides for Russell (they hit @19/56%).

#6 Sweet Shild O Mine (9/2) – ran a decent 4<sup>th</sup> in last race (@ mile dist.) – she is a front runner that will be a pace setter – she will appreciate returning to a Sprint race (trainer hits @12/51%) – Torres gets back on after being off in last race for Joe Sharp.

#2 Late Frost (12-1) – making 1<sup>st</sup> start off a 6 month layoff (trainer hits @16/31%) – has previously won 1<sup>st</sup> race back from a long layoff - has Early speed but can rate if need be – shows series of Sharp works including a couple of Bullets – she loves the dist. (7-3-2-1) - trainer Matz is very good working with runners coming back from long rest – regular rider returns.

#5 Anonymously (15-1) – ran an Even 3<sup>rd</sup> last out – making 3<sup>rd</sup> start off a short layoff – will need to improve today to hit the board – her last race was the our top pick won – she will be racing in a Pressing position a few lengths behind the pace setters looking for the speed runners to come back to her as there is a lot of it in here.

#6 Barbtourage (9/2) – she is making 1<sup>st</sup> start on Turf (trainer Ward hits @19/50%) – making 2<sup>nd</sup> start off layoff (trainer hits @30/62%) – sires' runners win 13% 1<sup>st</sup> out – mare's 1<sup>st</sup> out runners win @12% - very good Turf pedigree – is the Bris Prime Power leader - was a \$425k purchase for Stonestreet Stables – shows recent Sharp works – Johnny V. rides back (he hits @45/65% for trainer).

#5 The Amazing Mizzen (8-1) – ran a very good 3<sup>rd</sup> (only beaten 1 ½ lengths) last race – making 2<sup>nd</sup> start off the layoff (trainer hits @ 5/26%) – best Turf speed is close to avg. winning speed – will be racing in a Pressing style a few lengths behind the pace setters - regular rider sticks.

#2 Marian Cross (3-1) – making 4<sup>th</sup> career start – making 1<sup>st</sup> start of a 2 month layoff (trainer hits @16/49%) – best Turf speed is one of the best in here – should appreciate the return to Sprint dist. – drops in Class today – very good Turf pedigree - she is another that will be Pressing the pace setters - jock/trainer team hits @ 21/64%.

#8 Up for It (6-1) – she ran a very good up close 5th (only beaten 1 ¾ lengths) last out as the favorite (trainer hits @41% nxt. Out) – making 1<sup>st</sup> start off 4 month layoff (trainer hits @16/31%) – shows good pattern of works - should appreciate the slight drop in Class today – has one of the best Turf speed nos. in here – excellent Turf pedigree.

#2 Cats by Five (4-1) – ran a good 3<sup>rd</sup> last out at Oaklawn Park – making 2<sup>nd</sup> start off a brief layoff – trainer Asmussen has won this race 4 of the last 6 years – this \$575k purchase has not come close yet to earning his keep for Three Chimneys Farm (maybe today he will) – he will be forwardly placed waiting to make his move in the stretch – Saez gets on for the 1<sup>st</sup> time (expect to see improvement today)!

#6 Frost Free (2-1) – is the one to beat – has not been off-the-board this year (4-1-1-2) – ran 2<sup>nd</sup> last out after leading all the way but got caught – ships in from Oaklawn Park (trainer hits @56/56%) - earned the Best last race Bris speed rating – has the best speed at this dist. – is the Bris Prime Power & Class leader - he will be the pace setter and the one to catch – Wet track no problem - Irad Ortiz gets on for the 1<sup>st</sup> time.

#1 Mr Skylight (3-1) – won his last 2 races (trainer hits @32/58% nxt. Out) – looks to be a versatile type of runner (he can rate or lead) – shows recent Bullet work since last getting ready for today – is proven at this dist. (3-2-1-0) - has very fast mid-race speed – top jock Prat rides for 1<sup>st</sup> time for Riley Mott.

#3 Petingas Twin (5-1) – ran a very good 2<sup>nd</sup> (only beaten ¾ length) last out – has never been out of the Exacta (6-1-5-0) – has been the favorite in all but 1 race – likes to run 2<sup>nd</sup> - he looks to rate just behind the pace setter – earned the co-high last race Bris Late Pace nos. – stepping up in Class today!

#7 Catahoula Moon (9/2) – won last race (trainer hits @21/50% nxt. Out) - likes this distance (6-1-3-1) – earned the co-highest last race Bris Late Pace nos. – ranks 2<sup>nd</sup> in the Bris Class rating – local trainer Robb does well in Sprint races (hits @22/51%) – making 3<sup>rd</sup> start off layoff – shows recent Bullet work – he can race with the lead or rate behind the leaders.

#7 Union Fleet (5-1) – ran 4<sup>th</sup> in the last out in Stakes race at 7 Furlongs – will appreciate the stretch out today – the Class drop today should help – gets back to apprentice weight allowance – shows Sharp recent work – earned the fastest last race speed no. – earned a career best Beyer speed no. of 90 in last race – good jock/trainer team (they hit @50/100%).

#1 Armando R (5/2) – just missed last out running 3<sup>rd</sup> (only beaten ½ length) – he is a Closer that comes from the back of the field late trying to catch the pace setters – has won 4 of 5 starts this year – Wet track is fine – earned an 89 Beyer speed rating in last race – good jock trainer team (they hit @23/54%).

#4 Curlin's Malibu (20-1) – drops down in Class from Grade 3 Stakes race (should appreciate the relief today) – making 1<sup>st</sup> start of 6 week layoff (trainer hits @ 11/44%) – he is another Closer in here but looks like he can also be more forwardly placed – will like a Wet track!

#6 It's Viper (3-1) – ran 4<sup>th</sup> (only beaten 2 ¾ lengths) last out – has done well at this dist. (7-2-1-3) - has run well at this track (3-2-0-1) – earned career best Beyer speed of 86 in last race (look for speed nos. to continue to go up) Wet track is o.k. – Russell rides for Russell!

If anyone Scratches move everyone up and add in order #3 - #5

Win: #2 Sheriff Ronnie and a Bottom Wheel Exacta: ALL with #2

BEST Longshot:: #4 Curlin's Malibu (20-1)

Exacta: Box Top 4 selections (2-7-1-4) = \$12 for \$1 Wager

Trifecta: 2 with 7-1-4-6 with 7-1-4-6-3-5 = \$20 for \$1 Wager or \$10 50CENT wager

Trifecta: Box Top 4 selections (2-7-1-4) = \$24 for \$1 Wager

Superfecta: Box Top 4 selections (2-7-1-4) = \$24 for \$1 Wager - \$2.40 for 10 CENT Wager

Superfecta: Box Top 5 selections (2-7-1-4-6) = \$12 for 10 CENT Wager

Superfecta: 2 with 7-1-4 with 7-1-4-6 with 7-1-4-6-3-5 = \$36 for \$1 Wager - \$3.60 for 10 CENT wager

**NOTE: Best way to play our selections is to remember that our Top 4 horses should be your primary focus.**

**If there are any scratches, move everyone up to fill in.**

You can use them to play the Exacta by Boxing the 4 runners as well as doing the same in the Trifecta and Superfecta.

Consider using ALL 4 in the Rolling Pick 3s and the Pick 4 as well as the Rolling Daily Doubles.

The cost of a 4 horse Exacta Box for a \$1 wager amount is \$12.

The cost of a 4 horse Trifecta Box for a \$1 wager amount is \$24 or \$12 for a 50CENT wager.

The cost for a 4 horse Superfecta Box for \$1 amount is \$24 or \$2.40 for a 10 Cent wager amount.

The cost for using 4 horses in each leg of the Daily Double for a \$1 wager amount is \$16

The cost for using 4 horses in each leg of the Pick 3 for a 50 Cent wager is \$32

The cost for using 4 horses in each leg of the Pick 4 for a 50 Cent wager is \$128

The cost for using 4 horses in each leg of the Pick 5 for a 50 Cent wager is \$562

Remember that the 10CENT Superfecta minimum can be made in increments of 10CENT (i.e. you can 20C – 30C -50C, etc.)
